The day will involve elements of multimedia teaching, watching DVD and Youtube clips, group discussions with plenty of time for questions and answers and will end with some action points. We expect that the greatest learning will come from listening to each other's experiences in groups so do come ready to share your thoughts and ideas.

We will cover topics such as:

Signage, the difference between being a friendly and a befriending church, websites and written materials, the look of a church building, the welcome given and received at mid week activities, the welcome offered on a Sunday and being part of a welcome team.

NB There will be a refreshments break in the morning and almost an hour for lunch.
