


What can I do now?




Pray for the team as they prepare and for ourselves as we choose who to invite.

On Wednesday 28 November, they will be spending the day in Bartley Green School taking RE lessons, pupil discussions and being interviewed on BGS Radio



On Thursday 29 November, they will be in St Michael's School helping with a round the world day.

On Friday 30 November, they will be holding a joint concert for St Michael's and BGS


